BUILDING COMMITTEE UPDATE OCTOBER 2010

We have struggled mightily to match the community's needs-and-wants to finding enough money to make this work. We now feel that we are closer than ever to having a great design with a feasible budget.

PREVENT LICENSE PLATE THEFT

You can help prevent vehicle license plate theft by installing an anti-theft screw (seen below). They can be installed with a standard blade screwdriver but can only be removed with a specialized tool available only
