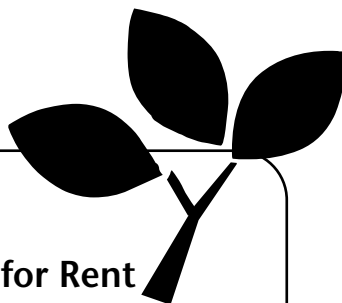

Weather & ice conditions permitting. Rink is closed if it's below -18°C or above +3°C. You can call the rink shack at 780-466-0651 during hours.

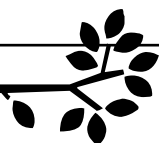
