Our Building Group Strategy

We are finishing a proposal to select our consultants and start the professional side of the project. The consultants will help to finalize the drawings and plans for the hall, and move us through engineering and construction. There are a host of decisions that we will make as part of the process, and these people will provide the technical expertise needed. Our plan is to have the consultants in place by the end of the first quarter of 2009.

Our Partnership Strategy

We have been working with another non-profit group, North Seera Hockey, who want space in the new building for meetings and equipment storage. We have presented several options to them and asked them to enter into a non-binding letter of intent. It is a framework whereby they will help with some of our capital costs, and in return they will become a partner to Gold Bar and our building project. The plan is to have the letter signed in the first quarter of the year, and proceed through the approval process with the community and the city.
