Edmonton 3-1-1 Service

Citizens can call 3-1-1, 24-hours a day, every day of the year for access to City of Edmonton information, programs and services!

Within Edmonton city limits, dial 3-1-1
Outside of Edmonton city limits 780-442-5311

Services available from 3-1-1

Citizens can access a range of information and services from the 3-1-1 agent including:

- Booking City of Edmonton inspections
- General information
- Facility scheduling information
- Program registration
- Purchasing a pet license
- Registering a bylaw complaint
- Transit information

Dialing 3-1-1

Callers will be greeted by a 3-1-1 agent. A majority of callers to 3-1-1 will find that the agent is able to assist them with their call through completion. In other cases the details of the call will be forwarded to the appropriate department for completion of service.

Non-emergency calls only

3-1-1 does not replace 9-1-1. Anyone requiring fire, ambulance, police emergency assistance must call 9-1-1 for emergency assistance. All non-emergency police numbers remain unchanged.
