Hall Renovation Proceeding!

The community league and building committee would like to thank everyone who came to the Special Resolution meeting on November 1st. The vote was unanimous that we proceed with the hall rebuild and renovation as per the design and budget presented. We are targeting April 2011 to commence construction.

Highlights from the meeting:

Our building and renovation project cost of \$1.4 million in round figures has come full circle to nclude landscaping around the hall, moving the rink, and creating new green space as part of the project whole originally approved at a community forum back in November 2007.

Incredibly, over \$700,000 has been raised (including North SEERA's \$100,000 commitment)! If our plans are approved by Community Services, and the City approves their 2011 budget to include the City of Edmonton Maintenance and Renovation Grant, we hope to receive matching funds from this program. If we are successful in receiving the City grant, we will be that much closer to the fundraising total, but will continue to fundraise for some time to reach the final goal.
