
How to Register



Hall Roof Info

To the residents of Gold Bar,

I would like to address the state of our community hall in order to clear up any misconceptions about its condition.

First of all the roof did not collapse; there was a serious leak which deteriorated a section of the ceiling which caused a 4' x 8' portion of the ceiling to fall. We have suspended rentals of the hall in the interest of safety The roof continues to leak.

At the next executive meeting, we will address the costs involved and hopefully proceed with the planned replacement of the entire roof, but on an accelerated timeline, in effect staging the renovation to replace the roof before we compromise the roof support structure and walls. We would then proceed with the balance of the rebuild as funding allows. The structural engineers involved with the rebuild will provide us with a plan to move forward in the earliest possible time frame and we will post updates in the newsletter.
